

7 out of 10 girls who age out of the foster care system will become pregnant before the age of 21.



POPULATIONS WE SERVE

We serve five specific populations of young women between the ages of 18 and 25.

- Females aging out of foster care.
- Females transitioning out of treatment with the Department of Juvenile Corrections.
- Females from dysfunctional families who turn 18 and do not have any healthy options for moving into adulthood.
- First time moms who find themselves pregnant but have no place to live.
- Females transitioning out of military service who have suffered some form of trauma.


All are among the most vulnerable for human trafficking

SERVICES

A Trauma Informed Care Model includes clear expectations, consistent schedules, a supportive environment, confidence building skills, activities that foster insight and self-awareness, physical activities that connect the mind to the body, and activities aimed at empowering survivors to use their own strengths to courageously face new challenges in their life.

Over 20% of children who age out of the foster care system still suffer from the direct effects of PTSD.

After reaching the age of 18, 20% of the children who were in foster care will become instantly homeless.

20% of female veterans suffer from PTSD.

1 in 3 females when seen by the VA healthcare system respond "Yes" when screened for military sexual trauma.



The ranch will rely on donations and fundraising efforts to cover all costs.

Once fundraising is complete, Sacred Heart Ranch plans to either purchase a property already equipped or purchase land and build.

The large property (around 10 acres) will feature a comfortable and functional multi-bedroom home with large living and dining areas. A large barn with animals will also be located on the property.

Our hope is to open in the near future when we can find a suitable property based on our fundraising efforts.
